The numbers are in and they're not good. General Motors was one of several automakers who recently released their latest monthly and/or quarterly sales results and, looking through them, it's apparent the Chevrolet Camaro is in trouble. Sure, the coronavirus pandemic is definitely a factor, but it's not the only one. Compared to its Dodge Challenger and Ford Mustang rivals, however, the Camaro's Q3 2020 sales plunge indicates an even greater problem. According to the automakers' reports, sales for all three muscle cars dropped in the third business quarter, but the Camaro suffered the biggest plunge. The Challenger remained number one (again) with a total of just over 16,300 units sold while the Mustang sold about 13,850 units. The Camaro, however, sold just 8,366 units, a nearly 32 percent drop compared to the same time last year. Chevrolet Chevrolet Chevrolet In Q2 of this year, the Camaro dropped an also alarming 46 percent compared to Q2 2019. Again, the pandemic certainly played a role in that, but a bigger picture is becoming clearer: the Camaro is in trouble. Despite Chevy's noble attempt at revising its trim levels in order to bring down prices, consumers are not responding the way bean counter and product planners had hoped. Ford has successfully managed to keep strong interest in the aging sixth-generation Mustang by launching powerful new variants, such as the Shelby GT500 and Mach 1. Dodge has been doing the same with the Challenger, most recently with the Super Stock. Chevy hasn't done something similar yet, for example, a new Z/28. In fact, it's becoming even less likely a complete Camaro redesign will happen. Around a year ago, there was a rumor claiming the seventh-generation Camaro had not been canceled but rather delayed. But that was then, pre-pandemic. The world has changed an awful lot since then and GM, which has been a recent history of discontinuing slow-selling models, like the Chevy Impala and Buick LaCrosse, wants to free up cash for its future EV and battery programs. The Camaro, based on these latest sales figures and internal projections, could sadly be living on borrowed time. The modern Chevrolet pickup debuted as the C/K models in 1960 in two- and four-wheel drive versions. These trucks were distinctive because of their lower profile and passenger car feel. The C/K models were replaced by the Silverado for the 1999 model year. Chevrolet developed the "personalized" pickup, commonly known as the "glamour pickup," which was produced from 1967 to 1972 and transitioned from a utilitarian workhorse to a family second "car" with added engine power, a more comfortable cab and custom sport truck options. The vehicle provided the dual function of a light-duty work truck on weekends and a passenger family vehicle during the week. In 1988, General Motors produced the flat-paneled Fleetside single cab, crew cab and extended cab, and the Stepside cab model, which literally had a step at the side of the bed for easy access. In 1990, the high-performance 454 Super Sport package was offered with a 7.4-liter V-8 engine and exterior features such as fog lights, red trim, a black grille, custom rims and "SS 454" badging. The Silverado and the C/K series come as ½ ton, ¾ ton and 1 ton models. Chevrolet trucks models are identified with a "C" for two-wheel drive or a "K" for four-wheel designations on the fenders next to the doors, with heavy-duty models badged 1500HD, 2500HD and 3500HD for ½ ton, ¾ ton and 1 ton models respectively. The Chevrolet pickup's sister truck, the GMC, or "Jimmy," was originally produced to be the luxury version of the Chevrolet line, but as Chevys offered more options and appointments through the years, both trucks became almost identical except for the badge identification. There's just something about a colossal V8, a supercharger protruding up from the hood, and tires wider than your tush that satisfies the four-year-old in all of us. Accordingly, their extreme proportions make them prime candidates for caricatures, be they cartoony self-portraits airbrushed under the hood, or actual, pint-sized pony cars, like the Chevrolet Camaro-inspired "Funtastik" kit car you see here. Craigslist Briefly produced in the early 1970s by a company called KAR Manufacturing, the Funtastik was a kit car based on the pan of a Volkswagen Type 1 Beetle. It had a fiberglass, Camaro-lookalike body, and according to a sales brochure, fully removable doors. The example you see here, which is currently listed for sale on Craigslist in Seattle, lacks those, presumably due to its shortened frame—note how much stouter this car looks compared to the Funtastik in the brochure below. TopClassicCarsForSale Said frame is advertised as being rusty, potentially signaling a need for replacement. Cutting a second Beetle pan down to fit this modified kit car body would take a lot of effort, but it'd let you move the body over to a Beetle frame with a registered VIN, as this car is being sold without a title, and may not be street-legal. Foregoing manual labor and just puttering around private property isn't an option, either, as this car's seller says it doesn't run, meaning your \$3,200 (or best offer!) is buying you a project car.
