Families spent hours sitting on their living room floors listening to the programs as a convenient way to enjoy a night in. If they wanted to go outdoors, a trip to the cinema was incredibly common. About 75% of all Americans visited theaters every week. If they didn’t have money for a movie, families or groups of friends wanted to head on unit for the fun of it. Road trips with no real destination were a big deal back in the 1920s. Who would have thought traffic could be so funny? If you were among the lucky inhabitants of the city with access to huge bank accounts, then the 1920s were definitely a good roaring time. A lot of nightclubs played jazz, blues and dance music throughout the night for travelers. Many of these nightclubs were also technically talkeasies who supplied alcohol, which was illegal during the Prohibition. Those clubs were where fashionable patrols adorned in short skirts and sporty stuffed haircuts and heavy makeup with little attention paid to the pressure of society to be courteous young women.
