(Please note: Applying for a passport as described in this article would be under normal circumstances, and not during a pandemic.) Here's what you need A completed application online or print this pdf copy to write in your responses. Proof of citizenship (a birth certificate or Consular Birth Report Abroad if born outside of the United States). Get a photocopy of the front of your citizenship proof and the back (if it has something written on the back). The photocopy must be on standard 8.5x11 inch paper, in black and white, and clearly visible. If you do not have a birth certificate, you'll need to check out these rules for secondary forms of identification. Proof of identity with photo ID: state ID, driver's license, military photo ID, employee ID, expired license, Medicare/health insurance card, or green card. You'll need a copy of this to include in your application submission. You must present one form of primary ID. If you cannot produce one of the primary forms of ID you can also use 2 forms of secondary identification including marriage license, social security card, vehicle registration, employer identification card, student ID, and/or yearbook picture. A passport photo. The photo must be taken in the past six months, in full color, on a clean, white background. Also it must have a full view of the front of your face and should measure 2x2 inches. No glasses can be worn in the photo and you can smile as long as it is not extreme or closes your eyes. When applying at a passport agency you can pay via credit card, a debit card that displays the logo, checks (personal, cashier's, certified, travelers), money orders, or the exact cash amount (no change is given). The entire list of fees can be found here.When do you receive your passport?Under normal circumstances, passports will be delivered by mail (if you mailed in your application) within 6-8 weeks. If you choose expedited service it will take 2-3 weeks to be ready. If you select to have the expedited service directly from the passport agency, it'll take 8 business days. There is also an option to receive same-day or 1-2 day service which would require proof of travel (airline ticket confirmation, accommodation booking, and/or itinerary). If you need a passport right away, you would need to apply directly at a passport agency that offers these turnaround times. For the movers and shakers among us, those never content with buying off the rack, the Bureau of Consular Affairs offers a number of optional extras — but they don't come free. As of November 2015, U.S. passports for adults cost \$110, plus an added \$30 for a passport card; first-timers pay an extra \$25 execution fee. For minors, those costs drop to \$80 for a passport book and \$15 for a card (execution fees stay the same). Travelers who need a passport in a hurry have a few options. You can request expedited service for an additional \$60 fee, which could shave valuable weeks off processing time. To really kick things into high gear, you can spend an extra \$14.85 to request overnight delivery. In cases of a life-or-death emergency, contact the National Passport any faster (see this list of tips for more useful info). Frequent travelers might burn through their 17 pages of stamp space before their passport sook when renewing [sources: U.S. State Department, Fees; U.S. State Department, Fees; U.S. State Department, Renew]. The bureaus will correct errors at no charge, but, depending on circumstances, name change costs vary from free to the cost of a new passport. A few key safeguards can reduce the chances that you'll lose your passport — and lessen the blow if you do. First, keep the document in a secure place, like a hidden money pouch. Second, as insurance, make two photocopies of your photo ID page. Leave one at home with family or friends and keep the other buried in your checked luggage. Finally, report lost or stolen passports ASAP by submitting a form DS-64 online or by calling 1-877-487-2778 (TTY 1-888-874-7793) toll free. You will then need to contact your U.S. embassy or consulate, so keep their contact info handy — on your phone and/or on cards in your wallet, luggage or money pouch. The State Department claims that built-in anti-skimming materials and authentication codes make the RFID chip secure.
