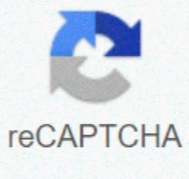

"He died the next day. On November 24, 1991, Freddie Mercury left the world that he conquered with his music. He died of british pneumonia resulting from AIDS.
