Meyer was the best-selling author in 2008 and 2009 in the USA, having sold more than 29 million books in 2008, [1] and 26.5 million in 2009. [2] Meyer received the 2009 Children’s Book of Year Award from the British Book Prizes for Breaking Dawn. The Twilight Series Finale. An avid young reader attended Brigham Young University, marrying at the age of twenty-one before graduating with an English degree in 1997. Having previous experience as an author, she conceived the idea of the Twilight series in a dream. Influenced by the work of Jane Austen and William Shakespeare, he wrote the twilight soon afterwards. After many rejections, Little, Brown and Company offered him a three-book offer of \$750,000 that led to a series of four books, several novels and derivative novels, and a series of commercially successful film adaptations. Apart from the young adult novels, Meyer has ventured to adult novels with the host (2008) and the chemical (2016). Meyer has worked on film production and co-founded production company Fickle Fish Films. Meyer produced both parts of Breaking Dawn and two other new adaptations. Despite this critic, Meyer is considered a feminist. Meyer’s stories have also received praise and she has acquired a following fan. Meyer was included in the list of Time magazine of the “100 most influential people in 2008”, [4] and was included in the list of Forbes celebrities of the most powerful celebrities in 2009, with her 2009 earnings that exceed \$5 million. [5] Early and personal life, Stephanie Meyer, born on December 24, 1973, at Hartford, Connecticut, the second of six children to the financial officer Stephen Morgan and Candy Morgan, a housewife. [6] [7] Meyer was raised in Phoenix, Arizona and attended Chaparral High School in Scottsdale, Arizona. [8] [9] In 1992, Meyer won a national doctor scholarship [10] who helped finance his undergraduate studies at Brigham Young University in Provo, Utah, where he received a bachelor’s degree in English Literature in 1997. [11] [12] Although he began and ended his career at BYU, he took classes from Arizona State University in 1996 and spring 1997. [13] Meyer encountered his future husband, Christiana [n 1] “Panchro”, in Arizona when both were children. [15] [16] They married in 1994, when Meyer was twenty-one. [7] [17] Together they have three children. Christian Meyer, formerly an auditor, retired to take care of children. [15] [9] Before writing the first novel, Twilight, Meyer had considered going to the School of Laws because he felt that he did not have the possibility to become a writer; More She pointed out that the birth of her eldest son Gabe in 1997 changed her mind, saying, “Once I had Gabe, I just wanted to be her mother.” [18] [19] Before an author, Meyer’s only professional work was as a receptionist in a property company. [15] The Twilight Series The Twilight Main Novels Article: Twilight (New Series) According to Meyer, Twilight’s idea came to her in a dream on June 2, 2003 about a human girl and an immortal who was to love with her, but thirty. [20] [21] [22] Based on this dream, Meyer wrote the draft of what became chapter 13 of the book. [23] He wrote from chapter 13 to the end of the novel and then he filled out the first 12 chapters, in secret, without an ideal audience in mind or the intention to publish the novel. [24] Meyer investigated the Native American cherries to include their legends and traditions in the novel. [25] although some members of the Members of Tribu Quileute found their use of their offensive legends. [26] Meyer joined the American Night Writers Association (ANWA) to aspire to LDS Writers. [27] In three months he had transformed the dream into a complete novel. [28] [29] Her sister’s response to the book was excited and she persuaded Meyer to send the manuscript to the literary agencies. [15] [10] of the 15 letters he wrote, five did not meet, nine brought the rejections, and the last was a positive response from Jodi Reamer of Writers House. [30] [31] Eight editors competed for the rights to publish the twilight at a 2003 auction. [30] [3] By November, Meyer had signed a three-book deal of \$750,000 with little, brown and company. [32] Twilight was published in 2005 with an impression of 75,000 copies. [30] Bimonthly booksheets and events at the changing hands bookstore in Tempe, Arizona, at the beginning of his career, the race helped him grow his fanbase. [33] Twilight reached number 5 on the list of the best sellers in New York Times for children’s chapter books within a month of their[34] and then rose to #1. [35] The novel was named the best book of the weekly editors of the year and the election of New York Times Editor. [36] Despite its success, Twilight was one of the most challenging books in 2009 according toThe American Library Association for being sexually explicit, for being inappropriate for age, and for religious opinions; some schools and libraries were asked to remove books from their shelves. [37] When publishing Twilight, Meyer had already sketched a story for a sequel. However, her editor insisted that she follow Twilight with two sequels after Bella and Edward in college. [38] As a result, Meyer expanded the story into a series with three more books: New Moon (2006), Eclipse (2007), and Breaking Dawn (2008). [39] The original story he released for the sequel would later be published in Breaking Dawn. [38] Meanwhile, Meyer wrote a short story “Hell on Earth”, about demons on prom night that was published in April 2007 in Prom Nights Hell, a collection of stories about bad dancing nights with supernatural effects. [39] Meyer’s fans urged her to expand “Hell on Earth” into a complete novel, but Meyer was busy finishing Eclipse. [40] In its first week after publication, New Moon peaked at number 5 on the New York Times Best Seller list for Children’s Chapter Books, and in its second week it climbed to No. 1, where he stayed for the next 11 weeks. In total, he spent more than 50 weeks on the list. [41] [1] In May 2007, Meyer held two promotional events at a gymnasium at Arizona State University to celebrate the special edition of the new moon and the release of Eclipse. For the event, Meyer wore a blood red evening dress and signed more than 1,000 books. [42] Meyer’s red dress was later auctioned for \$5,500 in a fundraiser for the battle of a book seller with breast cancer named Project Book Babe. [43] After the release of Eclipse, the first three “Twilight” books spent a 143-week combination on the New York Times bestseller list. [28] The fourth installment of the series Breaking Dawn, was released with an initial print run of 3.7 million copies. [44] Over 1.3 million copies were sold on the first day. [45] The novel won Meyer a British Book Award for Children’s Book the Year, despite the competition of The Tales of Beedle the Bard of J. K. Rowling. [46] [1] In 2009, Meyer faced accusations of plagiarism by Breaking Dawn. The Nocturne’s author, Jordan Scott, stated that the circumstances surrounding Bella’s supernatural pregnancy and her subsequent transformation into a vampire were similar to the story of her novel and indicated that Meyer set the plot of The Nocturne. Meyer dismissed the accusation, claiming that he had not heard of the writer or the novel. Scott did not present a copy of the novel to support his accusation; The Nocturne is not available on Amazon and appears as “temporarily exhausted” on his website.[47] The series has sold more than 100 million copies worldwide.[48] [49] In 2009, the four Twilight books were among the top four locations on the USA Today sales success list. Meyer was the best-selling author in 2008, and the first author to have books in the four best-selling locations.[53] The novels of Twilight occupied the first four positions on the final list of the year of USA Today again in 2008.[54] The success of the Twilight Series has been attributed to the internet, which allowed Meyer to connect with its fans, which led the series to be called “the first best-seller of social networks.”[55] According to the scholar Lykke Guanio-Uluru, the twilight series “reproduced and redefined the subgenre of paranormal romance.”[56] Twilight Saga Film Main article: The Twilight Saga (Movie Series) In 2004, MTV Films and Maverick Films by Paramount opted for Twilight before the book was published to maximize their potential benefits. The written script was far from the novel.[57] However, the film was launched. In 2006, Erik Feig, president of Summit Entertainment, tried to make a deal with Meyer making sure that the film would be true to the novel and that “no vampire character [seriously] represented with teethor incisive longer or more pronounced than those found in humansin 2007, the rights were sold to Summit Entertainment. [57] Catherine Hardwicke was chosen to run the film and Melissa Rosenberg wrote the new guideline. [59] Kristen Stewart was launched first as Bella Swan and Robert Pattinson was released as Edward Cullen after an audition with Stewart and Pattinson revealed that they had a good chemistry. [60] Taylor Lautner plays the role of Jacob Black. [61] Published on November 21, 2008, [62] the film received favorable criticsists; Roger Ebert called the film, “Lush and Beautiful” and Peter Bradshaw said it was, “very nice.” [63] The film was a success of the box office and became the highest quarter of November opening the weekend release until then. [64] Meyer makes a brief appearance of Cameo in a restaurant scene. [65] The same year Meyer began the work of him in cinema with the music video Mannequin de Jack “The resurrection” that he co-controlled with noble Jones. [66] [67] After twilight, Summit violated a cinematographic adaptation of the sequel, The Twilight Saga: New Moon. [68] Each novelty of adaptation was directed by a different director, chosen by Summit to provide each film with a different already existing environment in novels. [69] Chris Weitz directed New Moon [70] which was released on November 20, 2009. [71] On the night of opening, New Moon broke the R  cord for the highest gross domestic of a Day in the opening day that had been previously established by Harry Potter and the Prince of Mead. Luna. [72] [73] Despite their commercial success, the film received critical badges, Roger Ebert critic of the film and The Telegraph also said, “The film gives us all the necessary looks of desire tortured, and not much more.” [74] [75] Directed by David Slade, The Twilight Saga: Eclipse, an adaptation of the third book of the series, was published in June 2010. A article by The Guardian reported that it was the best of the series according to critical consensus for being more “cinematic” and hitting a better balance between romancethe supernatural. [76] However, an article from the telegraph, refuted the guardian’s statement, arguing that twilight remained the best film in the series due to the “counter of very straight faces between the forces of eternal darkness and the rigors of high school.”[77] Having already obtained the rights of breaking Dawn,[78] summit approved an adaptation of two parts. [79] [1] In 2011, meyer began its own production company, fickle fish films, with producer meghan hibbett. Meyer spent much of 2011 producing both parts of Breaking Dawn[80], as well as the cinematographic adaptation of the novel by shannon hale austenland. [81] the breaking Dawn-Part 1 was released on November 18, 2011, and the second part received criticism of the first part.[82] [84] [85] the second part of the film received more positive reviews with roger ebert calling at the end, sensational. critics also praised the performance, in particular stewart. [86] the twilight saga was successful at the box office, with a combined budget of 373 million dollars, the five-loading series won \$3.341 billion worldwide. [87] Despite commercial success, the films were widely criticized, breaking dawn: the hit part won seven prizes of golden raspberry (razzie awards) including worst picture, worst sequel and worst screen pair (for Taylor Lautner and mackenzie Foy). [88] so annual income exceeded \$50 million. [5] the same year, Meyer was classified no. 5 on the list of forbes of “hollywood’s Top-Earning women”, the only author on the list, and it was observed that the “twilight series of young vampire and attend titled Chemistry, about a former agent in the career of her employers.” The book was released on November 8, 2016. [126] [128] In 2018, it was announced that Meyer’s production company Fickle Fish would be working with Tomorrow Studios to produce a chemical-based television series. [129] Meyer reception on her Eclipse book tour in 2007, the reception of Meyer and her novels has been mixed. [89] [130] Weekly entertainment has declared Meyer to be “the world’s most popular vampire novelist since Anne Rice.” [131] while the Guardian described her as an “imaginative narrator, a prolific author and a newly powerful figure in the publishing market.” [132] Wayne James of the Toronto Sun agreed, saying, “Meyer’s success signals another trend”, the virtual dominance of the best sellers enumerates the past few years so it would normally be classified as a young adult fiction, “and pointed out”, in the absence. From a new Harry Potter adventure, teenagers, fantasy enthusiasts and women (sales are mostly to females) who fainted at the idea of a virginal vampire, Decan-ish Vampire, made Meyer a Gal for chaste love”. [133] Tymon Smith of the times described her as the “superstar of young adult fiction.” [134] Meyer was named one of MSN Lifestyle’s “Most Influential Women of 2008”, where she was described as “literary” She was also ranked No. 49 on Time magazine’s list of “100 Most Influential People in 2008”. [4] and was included on his list of “people who have dealt”, with author Lev Grossman noting, “Maybe Americans aren’t ready for a Mormon presidential candidate yet... But they are more than ready to anoint a Mormon as the best novelist of the year.” [136] She was ranked #82 on the Vanity Fair list of the 2009 “Top 100 Powers of the Information Age.” [137] Meyer was featured in an issue of the Biographical Female Force, a Blue Water Production title that celebrates influential women in society and pop culture. [138] Meyer was the second bestselling author of the decade, according to a list published by Amazon, beaten by J. K. Rowling. [139] Despite Meyer’s success, his novels have been highly criticized. The New York Times called Twilight’s premise “attractive and compelling”; however, the review continues, “the book sometimes suffers from earlier amateur writing”, indicating that Meyer has relied too much on “trying” instead of “showing” and that there were excessive vamping literature and therefore could not be influenced by it, scholars Anne Klaus and Stefanie Kr  ger argue that Meyer’s characters have similarities with A “traditional vampire figures” and that Edward resembles both gothic villains and Byronic heroes. [170] Meyer has indicated that, despite the supernatural and vamping themes of being a repetitive “jackhammer” masked behind ornate language. They also found the story to be uninteresting and the main character is not pleasant. [142] Weekly Entertainment stated that Breaking Dawn’s narrative was sometimes so chaotic and outrageous that Meyer changed the point of view to Jacob Black who only collected the chaos of the plot for so long. [14] 3] Novelist Orson Scott Card said, “(Stephanie Meyer) writes with luminous clarity, never foot between the reader and the dream they share. She’s the real thing.” [144] real.” [144] With Newsweek, author Jodi Picoult said, “Stephanie Meyer has got people hooked on books, and that’s good for all of us.” [145] Channing Meyer to J. K. Rowling, Stephen King said: “The real difference is that Jo Rowling is a fantastic writer, and Stephanie Meyer can’t write a darn. She’s not very good.” [146] The King went on to say that the appeal of her books was because, “[she] opened up a kind of secure union of love and sex in those books.” [146] American scholar of religious history Jana Riess had mixed reactions to Meyer’s novels. She found Mormon theology influencing her imaginative works sometimes beautiful and complex. However, she qualifies Meyer as a talented storyteller, not a talented writer, noting numerous technical flaws in her novels. Riess also criticized the “retrogressive gender stereotypes” in Meyer’s novels. [147] The Quileute has a tradition that its ancestors transformed from wolves to people, but most of the descriptions of Quileute in the novel are inaccurate. [148] The Quileute tribe described their use of their traditions in books and movies and later merchandising as cultural theft. [26] Fan that follows Meyer has gained a following among young adult readers of his novels Twilight, which are located in the small town of Forks on the Olympic Peninsula in Washington State. Forks has thus received the attention of fans, and celebrates “Stephanie Meyer Day” on September 13, the birthday date of the character Bella Swan. [149] Meyer fans cosplay their book characters, write fan fiction related to the stories, and attempt to recreate the “natural” manger” that is exemplified in character. As a vampire, Edward’s purpose is to be fleshly, killing and feeding on human blood. Under Carlisle’s direction, Edward decides to renounce this life and transcend the circumstances by becoming a “vegetarian”, choosing to feed only on animals. Chose to defend these values despite the daily temptation, which only increases when you know Bella; find her blood almost irresistible. [184] Edward suffers a transformation in which Bella’s trust in Edward allows him to trust in his own ability to overcome temptation and keep Bella safe. [184] Self-control is a prominent theme in the Twilight series, the word appears 125 times in all novels, while the protagonists struggle to control their emotions, attraction, thirst or jealousy. [185] Immortality and Eternal Life It appears in Meyer’s Twilight series is the theme of the distinction between immortality and eternal life. In Meyer’s novels, vampires are immortal and have gifts andsuperhuman; However, the Cullen family longs for things that can not have. Your circumstance circumstances they form meaningful relationships with humans or other vampires, isolating them into their small clan. In addition, Cullen family couples cannot procreate that causes severe bitterness in Rosalie that envies Bella’s ability to be pregnant. [186] According to Riess, the distinction between eternal life and immortality is represented by Bella, who in Breaking Dawn, has attained eternal life instead of immortality because it has attained the mormon principles of eternal life: immortality and a perfected body, eternal paternity and an eternal marriage. [186] Riess indicates that Bella receives immortality in an act of self-sacrifice instead of self-service while dying for the birth of her child. Bella is later resurrected in a perfected vampire body. In Mormonism, the resurrection occurs in the context of relationships, exemplified by Bella who enjoys her resurrected body in the company of her husband, son and the rest of the Cullen family. [187] The titles of novels serve to reinforce this idea. At the beginning of the series, Bella talks about leaving Phoenix and heading to Forks where she says, “[goodbye] to the sun.” [188] The titles of the first three novels: Twilight, New Moon and Eclipse, serve as a natural phenomenon in which the sun is dark. However, the final novel is called Breaking Dawn, which symbolizes the beginning of a new day and the transformation of Bella into a vampire and later transcendence of her old life. [188] View Religion The Book of Mormon influenced Meyer more than any other book. Meyer is a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints and does not drink alcohol, drink coffee, smoke, or watch R-rated movies. [181] [28] Similarly, there is no drink and smoking in novels. Despite the pressure to include an important sexual scene, Meyer was firm against including graphic sex in her series. [28] According to Lev Grossman of Time, part of the appealseries is due to your lack of sex and your eroticism of As a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Los Last Days, Meyer recognizes that his faith has influenced his work. In particular, she says that the characters of her “tend to think more about where they came, and where they can be typical.” [189] Meyer says that she does not consciously intend that her novels be influenced by her religion, , or to promote virtues of sexual abstinence and spiritual purity, but admit that his writing is made up of his values, saying: “I do not think my books are going to be really graphics or dark, because of what I am. There is always a lot of light in my stories.” [190] Growing, Meyer’s life and family turned around the Church of Jesus Christ of Los Last Days. They were involved in the community of her and a young Meyer was with her future husband in the church. She studied the Book of Mormon studied, citing the book as “the most significant impact on [her] her life” of her. [191] [192] However, Meyer does not like it when the media constantly mention the religion of it, affirming that the press does not emphasize the religions of other authors. [193] Meyer is cited as having helped bring to the Church of Jesus Christ of the last few days the mainstream of the books, the Mormons, the creation of an American faith by Matthew Bowman and LDS in the states United; the Mormonism and the manufacture of American culture by Lev Trepanier and Lynita K.
