And they’ll all transport you to faraway places or the kind of environment you’d enjoy spending a holiday in, whether it’s because of the time they were written or because of where they’re set. Photo Courtesy: Goodreads The oldest book on the list is the first in a series of five psychological thrillers written by Patricia Highsmith about her infamous character Tom Ripley. Although he is a sociopath with more than homicidal tendencies, the reader cannot help but stand on Ripley’s side while reading Highsmith’s compelling novels.The whole series is set in Europe with the first book that takes the protagonist and the reader to Sanremo, Rome, Palermo and Venice. In addition, it is a constant desire for a trip to Greece. There are many descriptions of the right picnic attire, the beauty of the scenery and the relationships that bind this group of teenagers and their teachers. And while Joan Lindsay’s writing style and setting of this novel may draw parallels with other classic youth novels written and performed by women, the ending of Picnic at Hanging Rock may have been written only in the 1960s. In addition to a methodical description of the city in the late 1970s, the book also includes references to a voyage to the South Seas that never existed. He tries to reconstruct his life in Tokyo in the 1960s and ends up in a relationship with two women who couldn’t be more different: Naoko, his best friend’s ex-girlfriend, and Midori, one of his classmates.The story takes the reader from the busy streets of Tokyo to the quiet of a rehabilitation center lost in the mountains near Kyoto. Americanh does for a great reading not only as an engaging and fun novel, but also as a study on race in America from the perspective of a non-American black person.
