
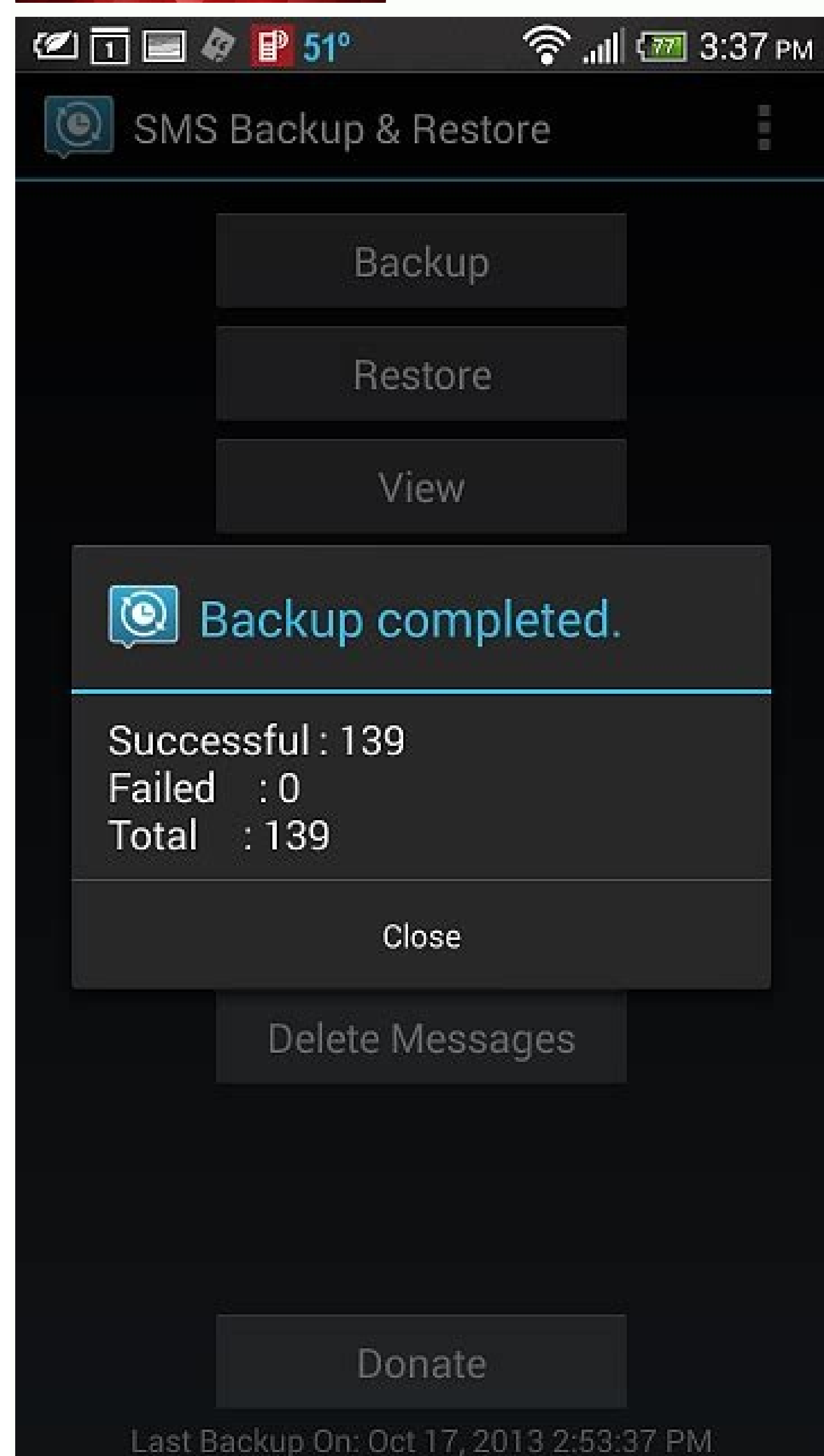
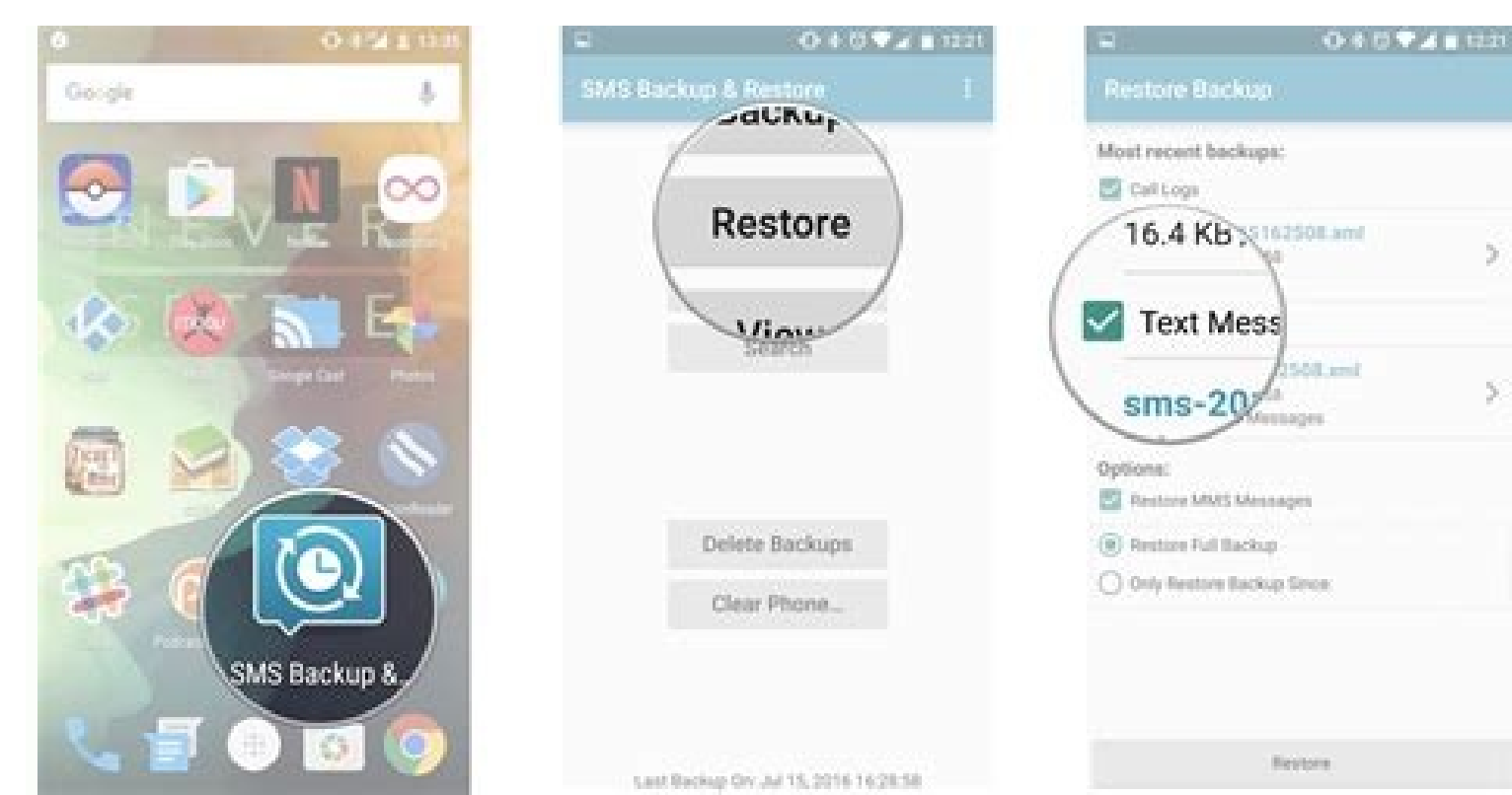

This has been a revelation for a long time. SMS Makeup does a great job of backing up all your SMS messages to Google Drive and restoring them without having to switch to a new phone. The latter is very important for my use case as I switch devices weekly and the SMS developer has been in this space for four years.
